2. What are the key strategies for making this happen?
3. What are your organization's unique capabilities for doing this?
4. How will your organization evaluate the impact of this grant/project? How will project results be used and disseminated?
5. Describe how your organization involves volunteers to increase the impact of your mission. Who manages the infrastructure which supports your volunteer resources?
6. What recent changes have you made in your operations, budgeting, or mission to become more efficient, and less demanding of Earth's resources?
7. Describe new challenges and opportunities you predict the organization might face in the next three to five years and how you plan to respond to them.
